Yummy Treat to Eat!

Valentine's Recipe

Looking for an impressive Valentine's Day dessert but don't have the time to cook all day? Use this quick cheat to make professional-looking Valentine Pettifors in minutes.

All you'll need is a frozen pound cake, 1" cookie cutters, confectioner's sugar, water and light corn syrup. Slice the pound cake into approximately three 1" layers, then cut out hearts & other shapes with cookie cutters (in a pinch, just cut into squares.) Mix six cups of confectioner's sugar with half a cup of water, two tablespoons of corn syrup & optional food coloring, then heat until the mixture is pourable but not runny. Place cake shapes on a rack & pour the mixture over them. Cool for an hour, then trim & add decorations as desired.
